Whether you're looking to step into first-time homeownership or downsize to a simpler lifestyle, this charming colonial – with eat-in kitchen, two bedrooms, a finished lower level and freshly painted throughout – affords a wonderful opportunity to the discerning buyer.

An enclosed front porch welcomes visitors. Ahead, the living room spans the entire width of the home. A broad archway opens to the dining room, and large windows on three walls provide abundant natural light. Equipped with a built-in sideboard, contemporary chandelier and four side windows, the dining room is equally well suited for casual dining or entertaining guests. Open to the dining room, the kitchen is boasts Shaker cabinets with quartz counter tops, peninsula breakfast bar with two pendant light fixtures, four-burner gas range, built-in microwave, dishwasher and refrigerator with cafe doors, freezer drawer and water and ice dispenser. A pair of windows overlook the back yard. Hardwood flooring extends throughout all three of these rooms.

The two bedrooms are located on the second level, and each features windows on two walls for comfortable cross breezes. The full bath features a tile floor, shower-over-tub with tile surround, vanity with integrated sink, wall mirror, double light bar and overhead lighting. A center foyer completes this level.

Situated on the lower level, the recreation room is the ideal spot for both an evening of quiet relaxation or use as a children's indoor play area. The adjacent office includes a wood grain tile floor, storage closet and overhead lighting. The laundry area is equipped with a washer, dryer and utility sink.


