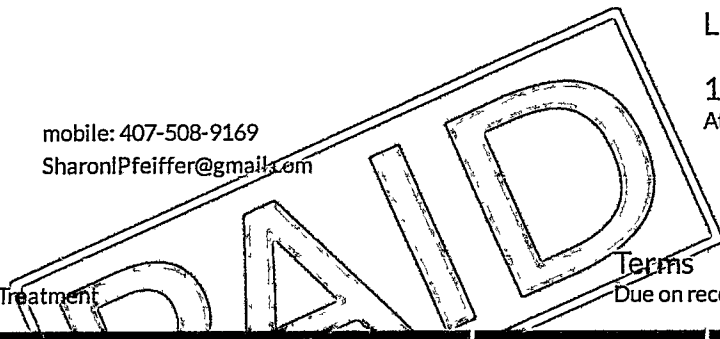

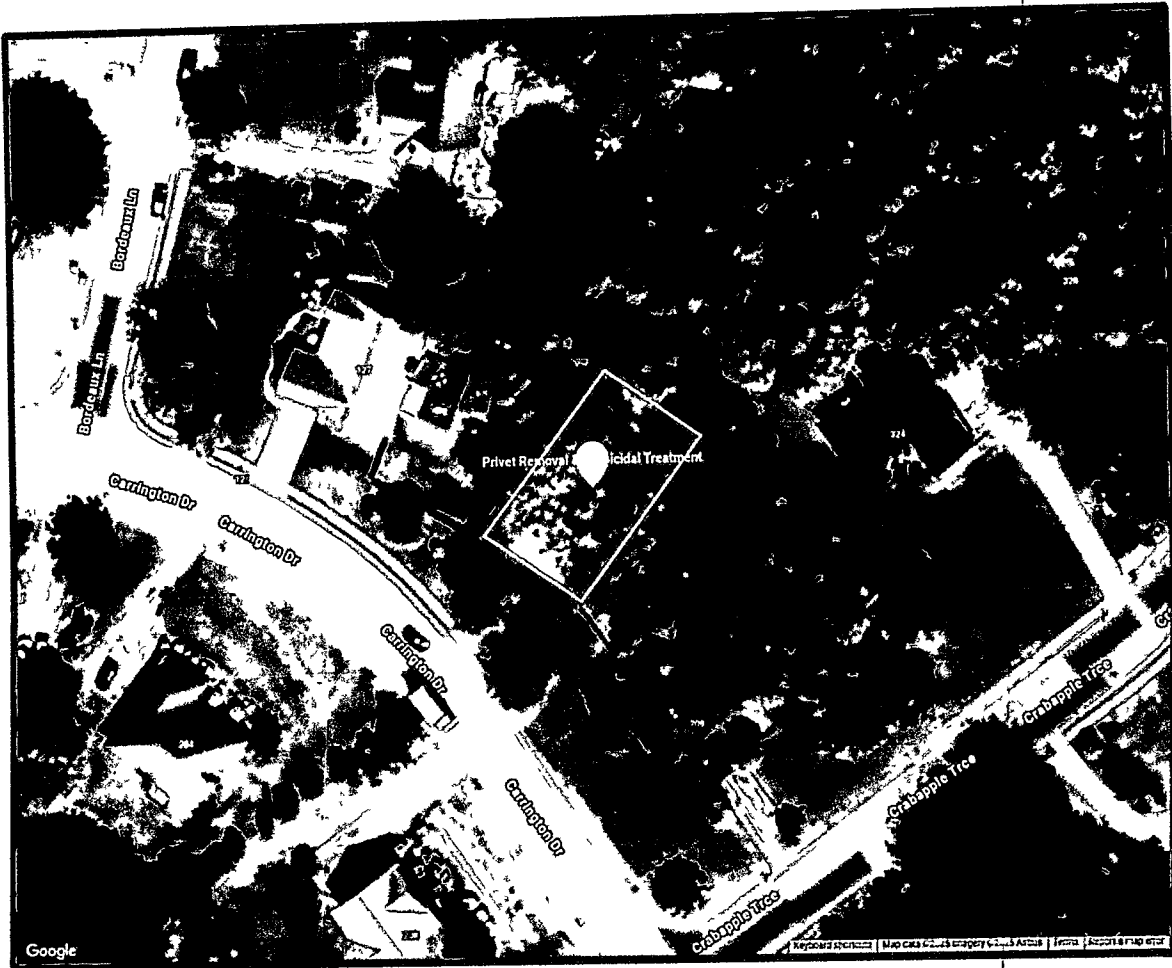

STANDARD TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- **Payment:** Unless otherwise provided in writing, the total amount is due upon completion of the job.
- **Alterations:** Any alteration, modification, or deviation to the scope of work in this Proposal that involves additional cost will incur an additional charge over and above the amount stated, for which Client shall be responsible.
- **Stump Grinding:** If stump grinding is included in the Proposal, and stump grind shavings shall remain onsite, unless otherwise specified.
- **Tree Removal and Trimming Debris:** Tree removal and trimming debris will be removed from the site unless stated within your agreement. Please allow approximately 24 to 72 hours to remove any debris too large to chip onsite during the date of the scheduled work. This debris will be picked up separately by Grapple truck.
- **Scheduled Dates:** The nature of the work to be performed pursuant to this Proposal is highly weather-dependent. Client understands and agrees that scheduled dates are subject to change and are not guaranteed.
- **Concealed Contingencies:** This proposal is based on visible trees, plants, and surrounding property conditions. If New Urban Forestry, LLC (or its affiliates) ("New Urban Forestry") encounters undisclosed or unexpected foreign material in the course of the work (rock, concrete, metal, stinging insects, underground utilities, buried masonry, stone, unsafe soil conditions, etc.), Client agrees to pay New Urban Forestry additional sums based on a time and materials rate for the extra work occasioned by conditions which were/are not apparent or explicitly specified in the Proposal or otherwise in writing. New Urban Forestry is not responsible for damage to undisclosed underground utilities.
- **Tree Risk:** Trees vary in size and structure, are constantly exposed to weather, and are susceptible to insect and disease organisms. For these reasons, all trees pose a certain inherent degree of risk. The recommendations made by New Urban Forestry are intended to reduce risks using tree care methods under ANSI standards. However, there is not and can never be a guarantee that New Urban Forestry's efforts will correct all unsafe conditions or eliminate risk. It is the responsibility of the tree owner or manager to determine acceptable levels of risk for his/her/its property. Some tree and landscape defects are apparent even to the layperson, while others require a trained professional and detailed evaluation. No technology can ideally quantify tree strength and risk; New Urban Forestry's risk evaluations and mitigation recommendations are based on the International Society for Arboriculture's (ISA) best management practices for tree risk evaluation.
- **Only Specified Trees Inspected:** New Urban Forestry arborists evaluate trees specified by the property owner or manager. Other trees are not inspected. There may be trees on the property that need to be precisely assessed. Recommendations herein do not constitute a tree risk assessment and shall not be construed to suggest that trees not explicitly mentioned are risk-free.
- **Tree Ownership and Border Trees:** Client warrants that all trees, plants, and property upon which this work is to be performed are owned or managed by Client or that Client has obtained permission from the owner to perform this work. New Urban Forestry is not responsible for any claims or damages resulting from Client's failure to obtain such permission.
- **Collateral Damage:** During tree care and removal operations, it is likely that the surrounding lawn, landscaping, and grounds will be impacted by such activity. New Urban Forestry will make reasonable efforts to minimize impact to the surrounding landscape but cannot prevent all damage. By approving this proposal, the property owner/manager understands that some degree of impact and damage should be expected and agrees to hold harmless New Urban Forestry for incidental collateral damage. Repair of said incidental collateral damage shall be the option, responsibility, and expense of the property owner/manager.
- **Driveways and Hardscapes:** To access this work safely with the appropriate tree care equipment, such equipment may need to drive over or be placed on the driveway, walkways, sidewalks, or other areas of the property. New Urban Forestry assumes no liability or responsibility for any cracking, breaking off, puncturing, depressing, or further damage to any driveway, patio, or other paved, bricked, stoned, concrete, or asphalt surface which may result from specific equipment being used to access the jobsite. Upon accepting this Proposal, the homeowner acknowledges and understands that any damage done to any driveway, patio, or other paved, bricked, stoned, concrete, or asphalted surface, by any equipment used by New Urban Forestry to access the jobsite will be the sole responsibility of the homeowner to replace or repair.
- **Cable and Brace Installation:** Cables and braces are installed per ANSI A-300 standards for tree care. Braces are intended to support weak or previously failed branch unions. Cables are designed to limit the movement of independent tree parts (codominant trunks for example) and to reduce stress on weak branch unions. Although professionally installed cables and braces reduce risk, cable and brace installation does not guarantee against branch or tree failure.
- **Indemnity:** To the extent of his/her/its negligence, New Urban Forestry and Client agree to indemnify and hold harmless the other from and against all claims, suits, actions, damages, losses, attorneys' fees, and expenses resulting from damage to third party property and/or injury and death to third party persons. Where such negligent or intentional acts are determined to be contributory, principles of comparative negligence will be followed, and New Urban Forestry and Client shall bear the proportionate share of any loss, damage, expense, and liability attributable to that party's acts.
- **Waiver of Special Damages:** Neither New Urban Forestry nor Client shall be liable to the other for any special, consequential, incidental, punitive, or exemplary damages resulting in any way from the performance, or lack of performance, of services hereunder, including lost profits or other business interruption damages, whether based in contract, warranty, torty, negligence, strict liability, or otherwise.
